At St. Mary's we aim to bring our learning to life through a stimulating and purposeful curriculum. During this half term's unit of work, we have been exploring rocks and fossils as part of our Science unit of work. We have been very fortunate enough to be able to organise a trip to **Kimmeridge** to study fossils and rock formations. We will also see the famous 'sea monster', as featured in the 'Attenborough and the Giant Sea Monster' documentary on the BBC. We will spend the day at the 'Etches Collection Museum of Jurassic Marine Life', with our time there being fully guided by one of the Kimmeridge rangers.

Class 3S will visit the museum on Monday 20th January and Class 3H will visit on Thursday 23rd January. We will leave school at 9am and return to school at 3pm.

Your child will need a **packed lunch and their water bottle** (if you have ordered a meal via the school caterers, this will automatically be replaced by a packed lunch if you don't cancel it).

Children will need to carry their packed lunch in a small **ruck sack** and have a **waterproof coat** and **trainers**. They will need to wear their **PE KIT** for this trip. Please don't send your child in with any money, phones or cameras, we will take photographs of the trip and upload to Dojo so you can see how we got on!

The cost of this trip, which includes museum entry and coach transportation, is £7.00 per child. Please pay this and give parental permission to attend the trip **by 17**<sup>th</sup> **January by the very latest** via their scopay account.

For this trip to go ahead safely, we need two parent helpers each day. If you are available to help on either of these days, please contact the office, thank you.
