<b>Year 3</b>	<b>I Am Learning French</b> Will be able to introduce themselves, say how they feel and have a wider appreciation for the country/countries where the foreign language is spoken.		<b>Animals</b> Will recognise, recall, remember and spell up to 10 animals with their indefinite article. 'I am' plus the animal nouns and determiners.	<b>I Am Able...</b> Will learn 10 familiar activities that they are able or are not able to do in French. Introducing the negative form, allowing the children to build more interesting and complex sentences including the option of using conjunctions.	<b>Fruits &amp; Ice creams</b> Will learn 10 fruits and be introduced to the simple opinions 'I like' and 'I do not like'.  Will learn 10 flavours of ice-cream and the transactional language required to purchase an ice-cream.
<b>Year 4</b>	<b>Seasons</b> Will learn the 4 seasons of the year along with a key feature for each season in French. By the end of the unit pupils will be able to say which is their favourite season and why.		<b>Presenting Myself</b> Using oral and written form in French to start to create sentences of their own using a range of personal details including name, age, where they live and nationality.	<b>My Family</b> Will make a presentation about their own / a fictitious family in both spoken and written form in French. Will use the possessive in French to manipulate language, changing from 1st person singular to 3rd person singular.	<b>In the Classroom</b> Will present both orally and in written form about what they have and do not have in their pencil cases and/or school bag in French.
<b>Year 5</b>	<b>My Family</b> Will make a presentation about their own / a fictitious family in both spoken and written form in French. Will use the possessive in French to manipulate language, changing from 1st person singular to 3rd person singular.	<b>The Date</b> Will learn days of the week, months of the year and numbers 1-31. Will have the knowledge and skills to say the date and when their birthday is in French.	<b>Do You Have a Pet?</b> Will present both orally and in written form about the pets they have and/or do not have in French. Will move from 1st person singular to 3rd person singular verb usage so they are able to say what the pet is called and use conjunctions more confidently.		<b>My Home</b> Will present both orally and in written form about where they live and which rooms they have and do not have in their homes in French.

<p><b>Year 6</b></p>	<p><b>The Date</b>  Will learn days of the week, months of the year and numbers 1-31. Will have the knowledge and skills to say the date and when their birthday is in French.</p>	<p><b>Do You Have a Pet?</b>  Will present both orally and in written form about the pets they have and/or do not have in French. Will move from 1st person singular to 3rd person singular verb usage so they are able to say what the pet is called and use conjunctions more confidently.</p>	<p><b>At School</b>  Will learn the nouns and determiners / definite articles for ten school subjects in French. Conjugate the verb 'to study', an introduction to time and an expansion of opinions. Will have the knowledge and skills to talk about the subjects they like and dislike at school (along with a justification) and at what time and on which day they study various subjects.</p>	<p><b>At the Weekend</b>  Will learn ten phrases for activities they may do at the weekend in French. They will also be presented with further extension on telling the time and opinions / justifications. Pupils will have the knowledge and skills to talk about what they do at the weekend.</p>
