
Spotlight

Advent

In the Catholic Church, Advent is a season of preparation extending over the four Sundays before Christmas. The word "Advent" comes from the Latin "*advenio*," meaning "to come to," and refers to the coming of Christ. It is a time to renew our desire for the Lord and to anticipate both the celebration of Jesus' birth and His triumphant second coming. Many people make Advent Wreaths in their homes or in church during Advent. This Sunday we lit the first candle on our Advent wreaths.
